The quartet comprising Francesco Patti on tenor saxophone, Andrea Domenici on piano, Giuseppe Cucchiara on double bass, and Andrea Niccolai on drums brings together a remarkable blend of talent.

Each track tells a unique musical story, guiding the listener through a range of emotions and moods.

From the urban pulse of "2048" to the introspective beauty of "Daedalus' Dream," their compositions present a sonic experience that reflects the depth and complexity of jazz.
